THE GREENWAY - IRELAND'S SCENIC TRAIL

The Waterford Greenway is a 46-kilometer (28.5-mile) walking and cycling trail that follows the route of the old Waterford to Dungarvan railway line, showcasing County Waterford's stunning landscapes and rich history. Starting in Waterford City, the trail winds through lush woodlands, tranquil riversides, and rolling farmland. Highlights include the Kilmacthomas Viaduct, offering breathtaking views of the River Mahon, and dramatic scenery through the Comeragh Mountains.

Historic landmarks dot the Greenway, such as the 19th-century Durrow Tunnel and restored railway stations. Information boards along the way provide insights into the area's heritage, flora, and fauna. For convenience, bike rental shops are available, making it easy to explore this picturesque trail.
